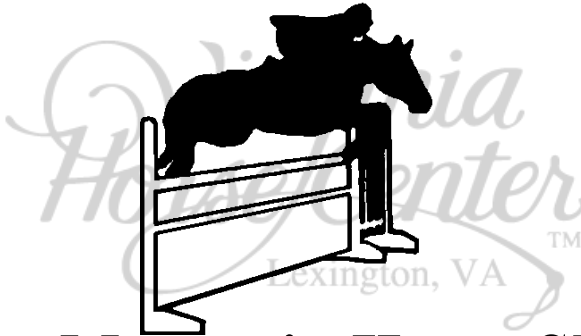

CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

GREEN HUNTER: Open to horses only in their first or second year of showing over fences at any height at any show. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 2'6" or 3'. No cross entry between height sections.

LOW HUNTER: Open to horses. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 3'.

WORKING HUNTER: Open to horses. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 3'6".

PLEASURE HUNTER: Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 2'.

HOPEFUL HUNTER: Open to all riders mounted on horses or ponies. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 2'3".

OPEN HUNTER: Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 2'6".

SCHOOLING HUNTER: Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 2'6" or 2'9".

ADULT HUNTER: Open to horses ridden by an amateur adult. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 3'.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER: Open to horses ridden by a junior. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Fences 3'.

SWVHJA HUNTER SEAT MEDAL CLASS: Open to members of SWVHJA who have not reached their 18th birthday as of Dec.1. Riders to be mounted on horses to be shown over a course of fences not to exceed 3'. The course will include 2 changes of direction, a combination, and at least 3 oxers. A minimum of 6 riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase is to count 50%. The same horse must be used for both phases of the class. A minimum of 4 entries are required to fill the class. If there are fewer than 4 entries, the class will be combined with the SWVHJA Adult Medal Class. To qualify for the SWVHJA Medal Finals, a rider must accumulate 20 points. After a rider is qualified for the finals, he may not compete in this class.

SWVHJA ADULT MEDAL CLASS: Same specs as for the SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal Class, except open to adult amateur riders 18 years of age and older. Ponies may be ridden by adults, but may not be shown in the Pony Hunter Division at the same show.

JUNIOR EQUITATION ON THE FLAT: Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of Dec.1. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1-19 may be used. A minimum of 3 entries are required to fill this class. If there are fewer than 3 entries, the class will be combined with the SWVHJA Adult Equitation on the Flat Class.

ADULT EQUITATION ON THE FLAT: Same specs as for the SWVHJA Junior Equitation on the Flat Class, except open to adult amateur riders 18 years of age and older.

VHSA ASSOCIATES CHILDREN'S/JUNIOR EQUITATION: Open to juniors mounted on horses. The judges will select at least one-fourth of the class to show at a walk, trot, and canter and to perform additional tests at the judge's discretion. Jump heights to be determined by each show. The rider must be either a Regular or Associate VHSA member or the points will not count towards the Associate year-end championship. Fences 2'6".

ADULT HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE: Open to horses ridden by an adult.

JUNIOR HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE: Open to horses ridden by a junior.

HUNTER PLEASURE PONY: Open to juniors mounted on ponies.

VHSA ASSOCIATES ADULT EQUITATION CLASS: Open to amateurs mounted on horses. Same specs as Children's/Junior Equitation class. Fences 2'6".

SWVHJA BEGINNER EQUITATION: Open to junior and amateur riders in their first year of showing. Fences 2'. No oxers permitted. Riders are eligible for one horse show year and may not enter divisions with fence heights exceeding 2'. This division not to count against rider's 2 year eligibility for the Intermediate Hunter division. To be judged on rider's position and control.

INTERMEDIATE HUNTER: Open to anyone in his first or second year of showing. Following beginner equitation division. Fences 2'3". Rider may not jump fences higher than 2'9" at the same show.

SPECIAL CHILDREN'S HUNTER: Open to horses and ponies shown by juniors. Horse and rider combination may not compete over fences higher than 2'9" at the same show. Fences to be 2'6" or 2'9".

SPECIAL ADULT HUNTER: Open to horses or ponies shown by adult amateur riders. Ponies shown by an adult may not cross enter into the Pony Hunter Division. Horse and rider combination may not compete over fences higher than 2'9" at the same show. Fences to be 2'6" or 2'9".

OAK RIDGE MEDAL CLASS: Open to junior and amateur riders. Over fence phase will consist of a USEF type equitation, A-O/Jr. jumper course of at least ten fences at a height of 3'-3'3" with spreads to 4'. Flat phase to count 50% and must run first. No martingales in the flat phase. Top ten riders will be called back for the over fences phase. Jump order is determined by the judge. Judge may require additional tests from USEF tests 1-19. Complete specifications are available in the show office.

SWVHJA PONY MEDAL CLASS: Open to junior members of SWVHJA mounted on ponies. Class to consist of 2 phases judged 50% each. The same pony must be used for both phases of the class. To be shown over a minimum of 6 jumps at the appropriate heights. A minimum of 6 riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. 4 entries are required to fill this class. A rider cannot compete in both the Junior Medal and the Pony Medal at the same show.

RANDOLPH-COLLEGE MEDAL CLASS: Open to junior and adult amateur riders mounted on horses or ponies and who have not qualified for a SWVHJA medal class or the Oak Ridge Medal during the current show year. Class to consist of 2 phases judged 50% each. The first phase will be the over fences phase of not less than 8 fences at 2'6" and may not contain a combination. The course must contain 2 changes of direction after the first fence. The second phase shall be ridden on the flat at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Judges may choose from USEF Tests 1-10. Martingales will be permitted in the flat phase. The same horse must be used for both phases of the class.

VHSA ASSOCIATES PONY EQUITATION CLASS: Open to juniors mounted on ponies. The judge will select at least one-fourth of the class to show at a walk, trot, and canter and to perform additional tests at the judge's discretion. The rider must be either a Regular or Associate VHSA member or the points will not count towards the Associate year-end Championships. Small-2', Medium-2'3", Large 2'6".

LARGE PONY HUNTER: Open to ponies, over 13.2h not to exceed 14.2h, ridden by juniors. Fences to be 2'6". This division may be combined with the Small/Medium Pony Hunter Division if there are fewer than 4 entries.

SMALL/MEDIUM PONY HUNTER: Open to small ponies, not to exceed 12.2h, and medium ponies, over 12.2h but not to exceed 13.2h, ridden by juniors. Small pony fences to be 2' or 2'3". Medium pony fences to be 2'3". This division may be combined with the Large Pony Hunter Division if there are fewer than 4 entries.

OFF THE TRACK THOROUGHBRED: Open to tattooed or registered Thoroughbreds who were trained for or competed on the track. This is a qualifying class for the Thoroughbred Celebration Series. Fences 2'6".

HUNTER SHORT STIRRUP: Open to horses and ponies ridden by children 12 years and under. May not cross enter into any other VHSA Associate division with the exception of Pleasure Pony or Pleasure Horse. Fences 18".

RULES

The Horse Show Office will be located in the Anderson Coliseum and will be open the day before the show from 12:00 noon to 6:00 PM. It will open one hour before the start of each show day and will remain open until the close of the show.

The show office number is 540-464-2962.

IF POSSIBLE, EXHIBITORS ARE ASKED TO LEAVE AN OPEN CHECK RATHER THAN CASH!

Upon arrival at each show, all exhibitors must leave at the show office a copy of a current negative coggins report for each horse brought on the grounds.

The Virginia Horse Center, the House Mountain officials and staff, and SWVHJA will not be held responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectator, groom, or animal at the show.

Camper spaces will be available at a cost of \$30 per day/night.

Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded in each division.

Schooling will be permitted after 12:00 noon the day before the show, and before and after each show day as determined by the course designer.

Any non-showing riders and horses will be charged a \$25 schooling fee and a grounds or stall fee.

Anyone without a stall will be required to pay a \$20 grounds fee per day.

Stalls are \$30 per day/night. Early arrivals and/or late departures must be arranged for in advance with the Virginia Horse Center Stable Office at 540-464-2966. Stall orders should be called in to Molly Moore at 540-261-6928 before 8:30 PM Sunday evening prior to the show. After Sunday, all stall orders must be called in to the VHC Stable Office at 540-464-2966.

1. **NO SMOKING IN COLISEUM OR BARNS -THIS IS THE LAW**
2. Vehicles:
DRIVE CAREFULLY. OBEY ALL TRAFFIC SIGNS.
No vehicles allowed in the barns.
Four-wheelers and ATV's are not allowed on the VHC grounds.
Non-powered scooters, bicycles, skateboards, inline skates, and heelers (skates in shoes) are not permitted in the Coliseum or the interior of any of the barns.
3. Dogs/Pets: All dogs/pets must have current inoculations for rabies as prescribed by state of residency. No loose dogs/pets are allowed anywhere on the premises. All dogs/pets that are not crated must be on a hand-held or tied leash. Loose dogs/pets will incur a \$100 fine. You must clean up after your dog/pet.
4. Coliseum: Absolutely no dogs/pets allowed in the Coliseum unless they are crated or are Service Dogs. Absolutely no dogs/pets in the Mezzanine (2nd floor of the Coliseum) under any circumstances with the exception of Service Dogs. We ask that your Service Dog have his/her vest on.
5. Grounds/Parking Areas/Barns/East Complex: All dogs/pets must be on a hand-held or tied leash.
6. No trash or sharps in the manure pits or stalls. Sharps should be placed in red boxes in barns and not in trash cans..
7. No lunging in posted rings. Wiley, Speed, and B Rings NEVER.
8. No overnight horses may be stabled in trailers or tied out.
9. Horses are absolutely not allowed to be ponied behind any moving vehicles.
10. Any loss, theft, accident or disturbance should be reported to the Virginia Horse Center Security. Lost and Found is located in the Security Office.
11. No firearms or fireworks are permitted.
12. The Virginia Horse Center shall be held harmless against all claims, costs, losses or liability of every nature and kind asserted against or incurred by camper arising or resulting in any respect from camper's occupancy and use of premises, and/or visitor and visitor's use of premises.
